



Sports Physical Program – FAQ Sheet

Can my child present to the Physical without a parent or guardian?; what age children can receive the Sports Physical?

No; children under the age of 18 need to be accompanied by a parent or legal guardian. Junior High & High school athletes are eligible for the Sport physical examination.

What is the cost of the sports physical?

\$25.00 CASH due and payable at the time of registration.

How long can I expect to be at the appointment?

Physical clinics will start promptly at 5:00 pm. Patients will be seen on a first come; first serve basis. No registrations will be taken after 6:45 pm.

Will my insurance be billed for the Sports Physical?

All sports physicals will be a self-pay service and \$25.00 cash is due at time of service. No insurance information will be collected from the patient at this visit.

Where do I park?

Ample parking is available at all locations. Please see map for the designated Clinic Locations.

Will I see a physician?

All patients will see Dr Jason Smith. Dr. Smith is a Sports Medicine; fellowship trained; provider who is the Medical Director for Sports Medicine for Mercy Health in the Toledo region.

What does the patient need to do to prepare for the Sports Physical?

1. Patient should present with their Ohio School Athletic Association form completed. Pages 1,2,5,6 must be completed and signed to begin the physical. Forms not completed when a patient registers will need to be completed fully before the physical visit will begin.
2. Patients are asked to present in comfortable clothing (i.e. shorts/T-shirt/flip-flops). This will aid in ease of assessment during the physical examination portion of the visit.

What if the patient has an abnormal finding or is not cleared at the visit?

Should the physician detect a concern with the patient's health that would need further assessment; the patient will be given the option to schedule an appointment with Dr. Smith or a referral to the provider of choice will be provided.
